## Vacancy Update

Regular visitors to the church yard will have noticed white smoke billowing from the church chimney! This is not however the Yorkshire branch of the Vatican and we have not appointed a new Pope, rather something even more special, a new Vicar. Hannah Smith is currently the incumbent of an East Leeds Parish serving the Halton and Osmondthorpe. She will be inducted as our new Vicar on 31st August.



Hannah was appointed unanimously by the recruitment panel and was much liked by all who met her. She will naturally have to work her notice with her present parish and help them prepare for their own vacancy. She is then taking a short sabbatical to help her prepare for her move to Sandal Magna. Clergy are allowed to take a sabbatical after ten years in ministry. We will learn more about Hannah in subsequent vacancy updates.

This is really good news and we should give thanks that our vacancy has not been as lengthy as it could have been and that the recruitment team were able to be unanimous. We thank them for their hard work. We pray for Hannah and her current parish as she prepares to leave and gets ready to join us.
