Hello everyone,

Many of you will know that I recently moved into what is now the 'new Vicarage' for Sandal Magna. One of the great joys of the new Vicarage is the garden – the previous owner was clearly a keen gardener and I am enjoying watching all the flowers coming to life and learning what is here.

My new innovation in the garden is a vegetable patch. I have wanted to grow vegetables for a while but have never got around to it. In this garden, there was a rotten shed which was taken down leaving a space which gave me the impetus make my vegetable-growing dreams into a reality. It has taken hard work – the paving slabs were removed and quite a lot of rubble, sand and roots have been taken out leaving me very muddy on some of my days off! But I finally got around to planting and now shoots are appearing – potatoes, carrots and beetroot are going the best so far.


